**Call to Order**

Mr. Barry Porter Moved that a closed session be held for discussions regarding the agreements being developed to fund and construct the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel project and the agreements being developed to fund and construct the project, including a Funding Agreement and a Master Tolling Agreement in accordance with Virginia Code Section 2.2-3711(A)(8) for the purpose of consulting with legal counsel regarding specific legal matters requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel; seconded by Delegate Christopher Stolle. The Motion Carried by roll call vote.
